- 3) Develop outcomes and expectations for the LIT program and communicate those with participants and their guardians
- 4) Recruit future LIT from campers or community, where potential is evident
- 5) Mentor LIT in their personal, leadership, and spiritual growth
 - a. Work to ensure LIT understand that they are valued members of our Summer staff team and have a positive experience while at Kingswood
 - b. Manage team dynamics and conflict resolution
 - c. Teach basic skills such as cleaning, dishes, and serving meals, and using these as opportunities to grow LIT in their personal responsibility, initiative, leadership, and ability to work with a team
 - d. Develop leadership training sessions and a short duration LIT staff training to intentionally teach, equip, and empower LIT in their leadership skills
